## THINGS WE CAN DO TO BE A BETTER WITNESS A T CHRISTMAS

I. Plan all other activities you have around your church activities, realizing that <i>faithfulness</i> in this area is of the utmost importance (I Cor, 4:2).
II. <i>Pray</i> and ask the Lord to open up doors of opportunity to talk to unsaved friends and relatives about the real meaning of Christmas (Col. 4:2,3).
III. Fix things around your house which will remind visitors of the <i>real reason</i> for the season (Luke 2:11).
IV. Include a <i>gospel tract</i> in your Christmas greeting cards or when you pay your bills ( <b>Eccl. 11:6</b> ).
V. Go out of your way to <i>do something special</i> for someone who really needs a hand ( <b>Luke 14:13</b> ).
VI. Ask if you can give thanks for the meals when you gather together to eat and share what Christmas is all about in your prayer (I Thess. 5:18).
VII. <i>Invite family and friends</i> to the Christmas activities of our church and make sure that you are there ( <b>Luke 14:17</b> ).
