INTRODUCTION TO THE SEVEN METAPHORS OF THE CHURCH

I. WHAT WE HAVE REVEALED IN THE WORD OF GOD

- A. We find that the church in God's program is likened or analogous to seven distinct figures or metaphors which are used to teach certain spiritual principles.
- B. As we would define the meaning of a metaphor we will see it is using one idea or relationship in place of another to suggest some likeness to it. For an example, believers have a relationship to the Lord as sheep do to a shepherd.

II. WHAT THESE METAPHORS OF THE CHURCH MEAN TO US

- A. Each of these metaphors is used to show some kind of spiritual relationship between believers and the Lord Jesus.
- B. Each of these metaphors teaches some spiritual truths which are based upon this relationship.
- C. Each of these metaphors will bring us closer to the Lord and benefit us personally in our worship and service for the Lord as we more fully understand them.
